Economically, it refers to the inter-dependence on each other through free trade. Countries have built economic partnerships to facilitate these movements over many centuries. **POSITIVE IMPACTS OF GLOBALIZATION**

Globalization has enhanced better communication between nations over time. This has enabled the market to provide amplified quality products at lower prices, scaled up business, increase cross border investment and so much more. These serve as pros to the world economy.

**QUALITY PRODUCTS AT LESSER PRICE.** Globalization encourages certain countries to produce certain products. It tells each country to produce products in which it specializes in. The small concept makes the production more efficient and fruitful. Due to this, business has also increased. And due to the competition in the business field, prices have gone down. Now, good quality products can be obtained.

**SCALING UP OF BUSINESS** In reference to business, globalization has definitely acted as a profit boomer. Because of globalization the size of market has increased, it is now a world-wide global market consisting of many customers. Large market enables the countries to reach more customers, and get a higher return on the fixed cost.

**INCREASED CROSS-BORDER INVESTMENT** According to the source Global Business, globalization has led to an increase in cross-border investment. This international investment has been shown to enhance welfare on both sides of the equation. Foreign investments also often come with, or in the form of technology, know-how, or access to distribution channels that can help other countries.

**INEQUALITY BETWEEN NATIONS** With an overview, global free trade is beneficial to the entire system. However, individual companies, workers and organizations can be disadvantaged by global competition. Globalization has helped narrow inequality between the poorest and richest people of the world. It contributes to one of the major job displacement factors. As a whole, it doesn't affect the world economy significantly but due to the introduction of new technology, there is a reduced demand for low-wage and middle-wage workers and a higher demand for high-paid workers.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HARM** Globalization has caused significant influence to our environment. Following are a few harms caused to the environment:

- ❖ Deforestation and loss of biodiversity caused by economic specialization and infrastructure development
- ❖ Greenhouse gas emissions and other forms of pollution caused by increased transportation of goods.
- ❖ The introduction of potentially harmful species to our environment. Such issues are now being governed by the government, either through existing or proposed laws and regulations.
